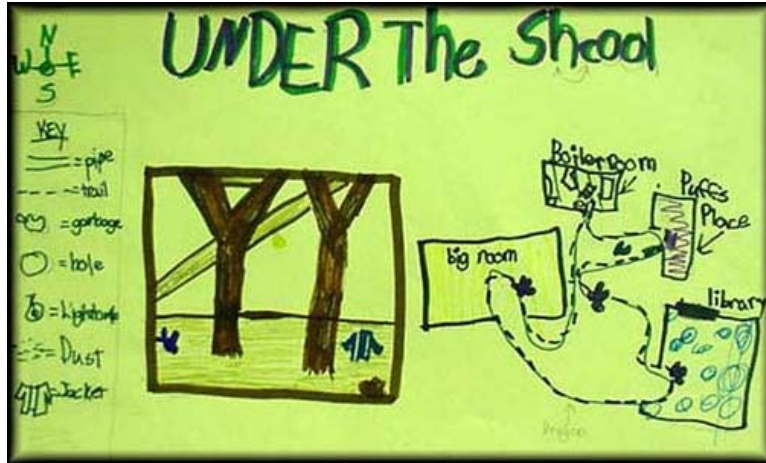


Underground Tour

Ms. Carlyn Roedell's 3rd and 4th Grade

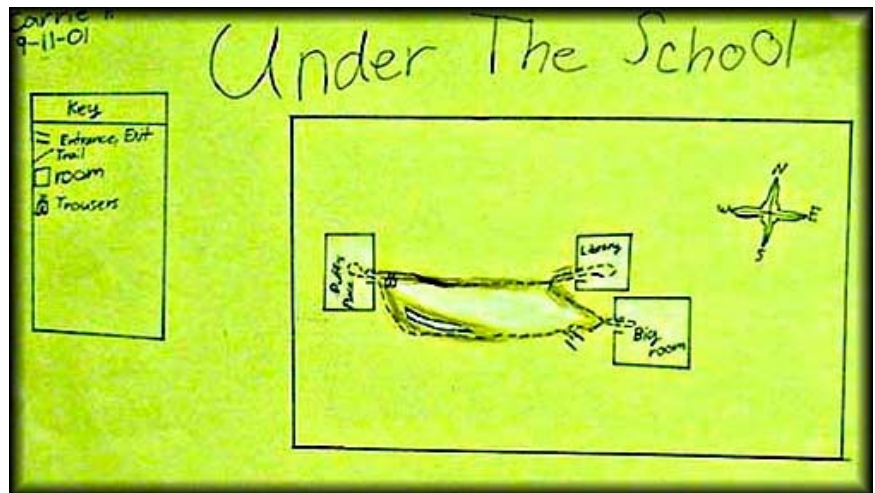

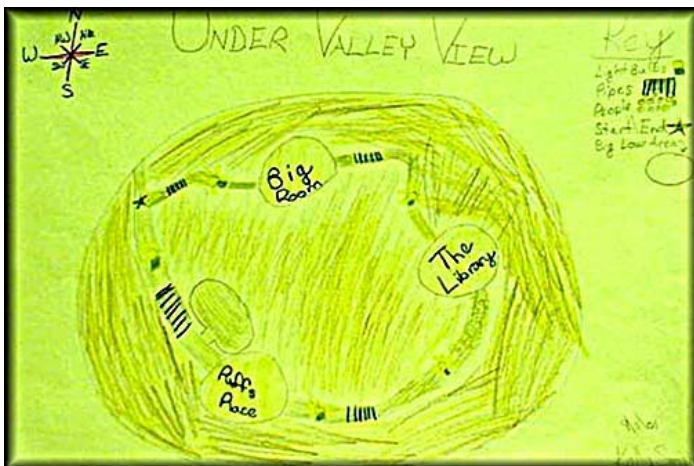
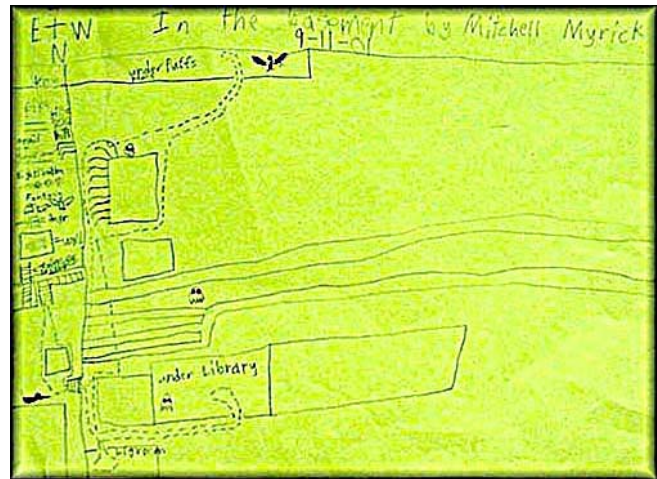
